This qualification reflects the trade qualified role of a bricklayer, blocklayer or paver who may have responsibility for undertaking heritage bricklaying, refractory bricklaying, bricklaying, blocklaying and paving work in residential, industrial and commercial contexts, in both existing and new constructions.

The bricklaying, blocklaying and paving industry strongly affirms that training and assessment leading to recognition of skills must be undertaken in a real or closely simulated workplace environment and this qualification requires all units of competency to be delivered and assessed in this context.

Licensing, legislative, regulatory and certification requirements vary between states. Relevant state and territory regulatory authorities should be consulted to confirm those requirements.

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ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 18 years or over
- Basic computer skills (Word, Excel or similar)
- LLN proficiency sufficient for a minimum entry level worker (AQF level III) in the field of construction.
- Access to a compliant construction worksite(s) with the full range of environments, equipment and facilities that meet training package requirements.
- Holds a current White Card and/or Site Specific Induction

RPL CANDIDATES

Candidates must provide evidence of currency and experience by working in the bricklaying/blocklaying field of construction for a minimum of 12 months within the past 18 months. A letter on company letterhead from current/past employer(s) verifying this is required.

COURSE DELIVERY

The qualification offers a maximum period of 104 weeks (including 8 weeks holiday) from the date of commencement in which to complete their studies and submit all work for assessment. Students will attend face-to-face 2 x days per week 9am-5pm. This includes training and assessment. In addition students are required to complete up to a maximum of 5 hours per week independent, unsupervised activities.
