This qualification provides a trade outcome in wall and floor tiling for residential and commercial construction work. The qualification has core unit of competency requirements that cover common skills for the construction industry, as well as the specialist field of work, wall and floor tiling. Tilers work with materials like ceramic, glass, slate, marble and clay. They cut these materials and lay tiles on walls and floors, both interior and exterior. They may also add decorative touches to their basic work.



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ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 18 years or over
- Basic computer skills (Word, Excel or similar)
- LLN proficiency sufficient for a minimum entry level worker (AQF level III) in the wall and floor tiling field of construction.
- Access to a compliant construction worksite(s) with the full range of environments, equipment and facilities that meet training package requirements.
- Holds a current White Card and/or Site Specific Induction

RPL CANDIDATES

Candidates must provide evidence of currency and experience by working in the wall and ceiling lining field of construction for a minimum of 12 months within the past 18 months. A letter on company letterhead from current/past employer(s) verifying this is required.

COURSE DELIVERY

The qualification offers a maximum period of 104 weeks (including 8 weeks holiday) from the date of commencement in which to complete their studies and submit all work for assessment. Students will attend face-to-face 2 x days per week 9am-5pm. This includes training and assessment. In addition students are required to complete up to a maximum of 5 hours per week independent, unsupervised activities.
