This qualification reflects the role of builders, site managers and managers of small to medium-sized building businesses who apply knowledge of structural principles, codes, standards and legal requirements to Class 1 and 10, to a maximum of two storeys and Class 2 to 9 Type C constructions, and who plan and supervise safe building and construction work, prepare and administer contracts, and who apply quality principles to building and construction projects.

Building relates to construction and Site Management is about managing the factors around construction, such as the deployment of crews with specialised skills (including builders), product compliance, deployment of contract specialised skills, weather and site location.

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ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 18 years or over
- Basic computer skills (Word, Excel or similar)
- LLN proficiency sufficient for a minimum entry level worker (AQF level III) in the field of construction.
- Access to a compliant construction worksite(s) with the full range of environments, equipment and facilities that meet training package requirements.
- Holds a current White Card and/or Site Specific Induction

RPL CANDIDATE

Candidates must provide evidence of currency and experience by working in the building and construction field for a minimum of 12 months within the past 18 months. A letter on company letterhead from current/past employer(s) verifying this is required.

COURSE DELIVERY

The qualification offers a maximum period of 52 weeks (including 4 weeks holiday) from the date of commencement in which to complete their studies and submit all work for assessment. Students will attend face-to-face 2 x days per week 9am-5pm. This includes training and assessment. In addition students are required to complete up to a maximum of 5 hours per week independent, unsupervised activities.
